OUT OF IDEAS FOR PLEDGE TRAINING???

Jennifer and I planned a **Pledge Retreat** at my family's cabin and eight of us attended. We arrived Friday night and left on Sunday after lunch. A typed program was brought along.

Each of us were divided into **groups of two** to plan and purchase food for meals with Sunday being the day for leftovers. Jennifer and I had made some **goodie bags** for everyone with pens with yellow roses on top, chip clips, BSP car decals, hotel lotions and other items.

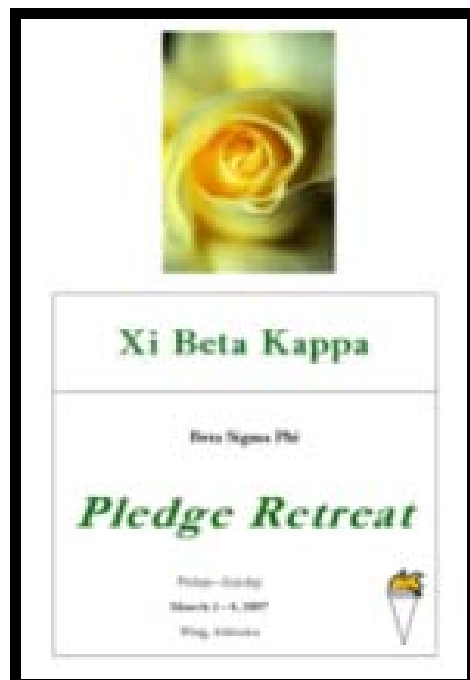
Also, Jennifer and I provided **notebooks** which we divided into sections—1. **Helpful information:** Highlights of BSP, How to wear your pin, Program tips & Greek Alphabet; 2. **Forms and Applications:** Membership, Legacy, Change of add, & Sponsors, directors etc; 3. **Officer Responsibilities:** Pres, VP, Treasurer, Recording Secretary, & Corresponding Secretary; and then the last section was 4. **Awards:** PACE, Chapter of the Year, Pledge of the Year, Woman of the Year and 5. **Surveys:** Member Interest Survey. NOTE: *Much of this was downloaded off of the Internet prior to the Retreat. I had also printed labels and stuck them on 3x5 cards for each Pledge. Questions were on one side and answers on the other as a way for us to study for the Pledge test. This info came out of the book of Beta Sigma Phi and from the Strawberry Patch on line.*

As part of the Retreat, we learned to play **Bunco, did reflexology & line danced.** (The ones that knew taught the one's that didn't know) We did **word searches** and a "**Pig Personality**" test. Had a **toilet paper exercise** where you "take as much as you think you need" and later have to tell things no one else knows about you. You have to tell one thing for ever square you took. If you took 10 pieces you have to tell 10 things. We had **undecorated tags** for every occasion we could think of for Secret Sister gifts. We decorated them with stickers and put ribbon on them. We made one set for each of us. We also had "**Threads of Friendship**" poems that we trimmed and put ribbon through to be used as a Ways & Means item at Gulf Area. We also held our elections for 2007-08 officers, PACE award, pledge and woman of the year.

Everyone contributed at some level. We all had a great time bonding and learned things about each other we didn't know. Some had been together for years, but half of us were new to the chapter.

By the way, we alternated shifts on showering to have enough hot water for everyone. :-)

* Even if you do not have osteoporosis, you should check with your health care provider before you start an exercise program.

* Remember to warm up before starting and cool down at the end of each exercise session.

* For the best benefit to your bone health, combine several different weight-bearing exercises.

* As you build strength, increase resistance, or weights, rather than repetitions.

* Remember to drink plenty of water whenever exercising

* Do the exercises at least 3 times a week
