A BSP came to me and said that they had been totally wiped out and that her husband takes care of her mother who has Alzheimer's while the BSP works. He reads to the mother in law constantly and only inspirational material. When I mentioned that among the books sent, were inspirational books, she asked if her husband could have them to read to her mother.

It's his thought that some of it gets through the fog of Alzheimer's, certainly does him good and that it is a good way to spend

their time together. So those books are all spoken for. She asked in particular if there were any books by Max Lucado in the boxes. I was pretty sure there weren't but I told her there were several other inspirational authors included in the Montana shipment.

So this lead to a general discussion of who still needed what and what we might have on hand here to share or trade.

Sandy D. was there and spoke about how generous on line has been to her. I was able to give her a red hat visor that Julia brought when she came over to bring her chapter's very generous donation. But the morning we left the house to go meet Sandy, we left the visor on the counter, so she has it now. Then Sandy said she had heard from Loretta C. and that some of Loretta's church members are in the area and Sandy will be contacting them. I also have another large box here to take to Sandy from Charlotte A. when I go to chapter tomorrow night.

Then last night was something really special at our church. Several weeks ago we signed up for a candle light supper in our church to honor World Marriage Day. We thought this would be a nice but rather standard church event.

Last night the lights had been dimmed and the only light came from strings of white lights wrapped in white tulle had been strung from the ceiling in a star burst pattern. Where the rays of the star came down the wall, it was tied with a huge red bow of tulle.

There must have been 20 or 30 rays soft white twinkle lights. Then we had "chandeliers" made from deep glass bowls with floating candles. The bowls were trimmed with red roses and hung in a sort of sling of red tulle with red roses underneath. On the table where Champaign glasses with either white, pink or red rose candles floating in them. Our wine glasses had red napkins fluted in them and white table clothes. It was truly a fairly land of light and magic. The buffet was catered and I think we had about 5 choices of wine. The food was wonderful and included a dessert buffet.

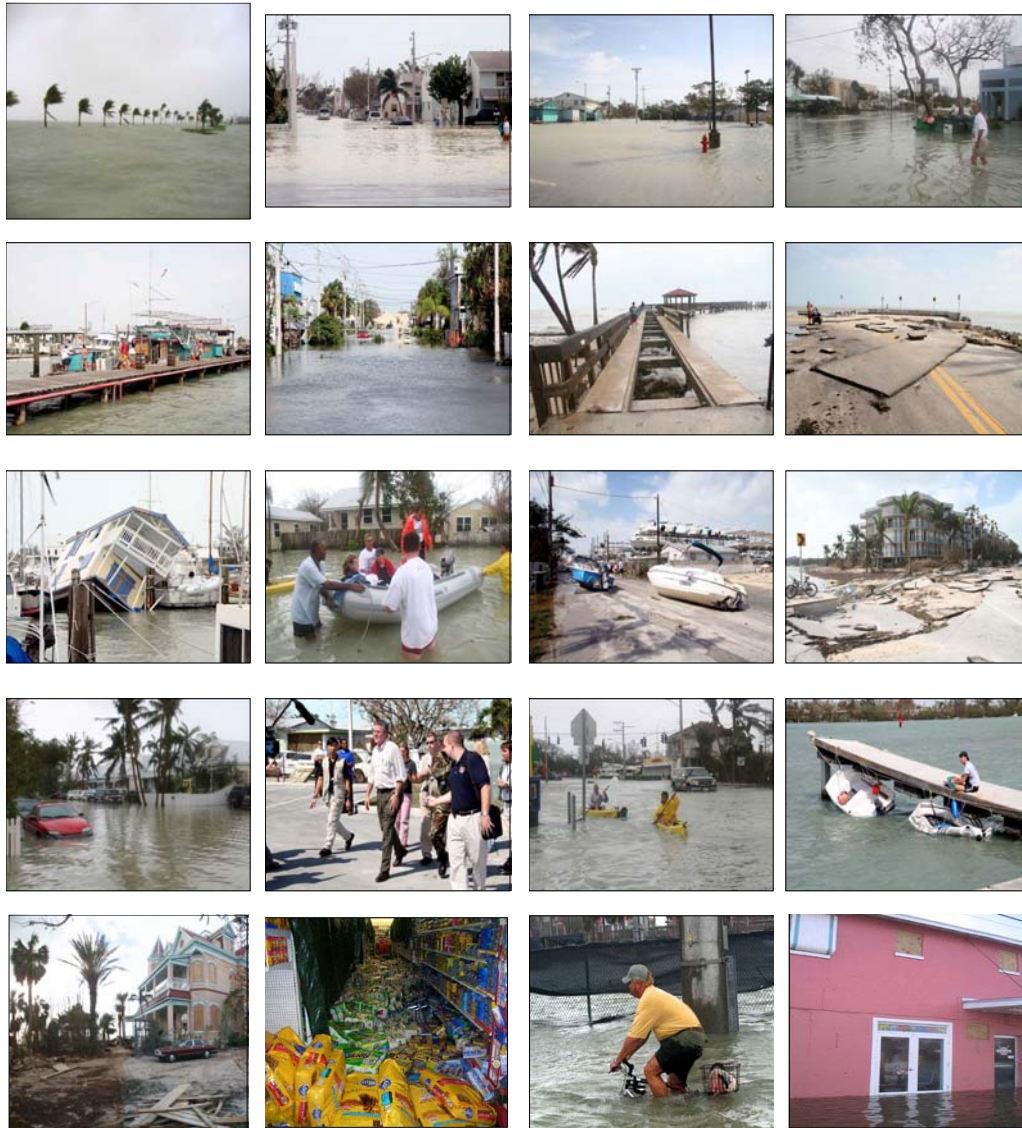
were done to reflect our marriage them. Jerry's said Jerry loves Judy Clarke and mine said Judy loves Jerry Clarke. And that is certainly true!
